Introduction and aim

Praxis is a printing business operating from a site in north London. We recognise that our operations result in emissions to air and water, and the generation of waste. It is our aim to comply with legislation and other requirements, continue to reduce the environmental impacts of our business and operate in an environmentally responsible manner. This policy describes how we will achieve our aim.

Responsibility

Objectives

- ensure a high proportion of our waste is recycled or reused
- encourage employees to consider environmentally friendly methods for commuting to and from the workplace
- ensure we select suppliers and materials that minimise environmental impact
- design and develop durable and re-usable products
- select delivery methods with reduced environmental impact
- manage energy use at business premises as efficiently as possible
